



# National Lottery support for the fleet launch Cingalee to mark First World War Centenary

The Orkney Historic Boat Society (OHBS) has received a grant of £9,100 from the National Lottery Heritage Fund for a project to save the First World War fleet launch Cingalee in Orkney. Awarded through its *First World War: then and now* programme, the project will focus on restoring the Cingalee to her original 1905 layout.

To mark the Centenary of the First World War, the project will enable local people in Scotland to come together to preserve the memories and heritage of the people who lived through the First World War. Volunteers will assist professional boat builders to restore the boat.

Commenting on the award, James Clouston (OHBS Chairman) said: "We are delighted that the National Lottery Heritage Fund appreciate the significance of Cingalee's place in Orkney's maritime heritage. With the National Lottery Heritage Fund we can restore Cingalee in time for the Scapa 100 commemoration event in June".

Ríona McMorrow, Acting Head of The National Lottery Heritage Fund Scotland, said: "The impact of the First World War was far reaching, touching every corner of the UK. With our small grants programme, we are enabling even more communities like those involved in Save the Fleet Launch Cingalee which served the Royal Navy in the First World War to explore the continuing legacy of this conflict and help local young people in particular to broaden their understanding of how it has shaped our modern world."
